Entry Fees

PCAV \$50

OPEN \$50 All open riders must complete the Public Liability Declaration. A day insurance cover of \$10 is payable for those without appropriate insurance.

Facility Fee \$5 per entry

Yard Hire \$10. Limited yards available, first in basis.

Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. All open riders must complete the Public Liability Declaration; there is a \$10 day insurance cover for those without appropriate insurance.
2. Open riders must, with the exception of uniform, comply with all PCAV rules including gear check requirements before each phase.
3. PCAV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office prior to riding.
4. All refunds will incur a \$10 administration fee. No refunds after closing date unless notified prior to ride time and a valid vet or medical certificate is supplied to kslade@eventsecretary.org.au within seven days of notification of scratching.
5. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules. PCAV rules may be found at www.ponyclubvic.org.au

6. PCAV Gear Rules as at 1 February 2016 apply. Please ensure you comply, as non compliance may mean elimination.
7. All dressage tests from the NEW 'PCAV Dressage Tests' Effective Jan 2013 booklet
8. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of PCAV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules and if entry numbers permit.
9. Complying helmets must be worn, spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.
10. Gear Check is mandatory before riding in each phase of the competition.
11. Armbands: must be worn by all competitors (applies to PCAV & non PCAV riders) and inspected at gear check for competitor's name & emergency contact name & number.
12. Riders under eight years of age may not compete, horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
13. Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. **Every competitor must supply their own back number holder and wear it for all three phases of competition.**
14. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
15. Dogs are prohibited without exception, **any dog at the competition will be sent home immediately.**
16. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
17. The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or event, divide any class, alter the advertised times, and to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason. **In the event of 6 or less entries into a class PC and Open classes will be combined with a maximum of 12 entries total.**
18. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
19. PCAV count back system used to split equal placings.
20. **Lungeing** of horses / ponies will not be permitted at this competition.
21. **Kyneton Pony Club** requests all exhibitors take their **manure** away with them.

At the time of entering you will be asked for contact details for helping on the day.
